What you told us about the draft plan for Ingleside

At our most recent consultation you provided us with valuable feedback.

Some of the topics raised in submissions include:

- **transport planning**, especially the upgrade of Mona Vale Road;
- **environmental concerns**, including the conservation of bushland and native flora and fauna, and wildlife corridors;
- **bushfire risk and emergency access**;
- appropriate **residential housing types** across the precinct;
- how to **make Ingleside sustainable**.



How did we consult with you?

We spoke to	283 people	at drop in sessions
We heard from	426 community members and agencies	through formal submissions
There were	80 comments from 39 people	on Social Pinpoint
There were	65 responses	to the survey
There were	13,997 visits on the webpage	from December 2016 - February 2017
